

Parking Use at the Fletcher Branch

The Fletcher Branch of the Washington County Free Library system located in downtown, Hagerstown has a large parking lot located behind the facility. This lot is accessible both from Baltimore Street and from the alley behind the library.

This lot is gate controlled, therefore, when you approach, **you must take a parking ticket.**

When you intend to return to your car, validate your parking ticket at the main Customer Service Desk located on the second floor. The library offers 2 hours of FREE parking. If you are in the library more than 2 hours, proceed to the first floor to the Parking Pay Station located opposite the staircase in the atrium for payment. Payment by credit card is also available at the gate.

Parking Pay Station: Insert your ticket as indicated, follow the instructions. The kiosk will inform you if there is a balance due on your ticket. The machine accepts both cash and credit. After you have paid for your parking, you have 15 minutes to return to your car and exit the parking lot.

The lot is accessible 24/7. If you use the parking lot when the library is not open, the gate will accept credit card payments for time used.

In the rare event the system is not working, you can push the Help button and a monitoring company will assist you.
